Judo Gis:

- 1. White Judo gi is preferred; you are encouraged to bring your own blue and white belts.
- 2. Colored Judo/Jujitsu/Karate gis will be allowed, but must adhere to Judo gi rules for pants and sleeve lengths.
- 3. No "rolled up" sleeves or pants will be allowed.
- 4. Competitor's pants and jackets must be the same color.
- 5. Jujitsu patches will be allowed unless the patches interfere with grips.
- 6. Competitors will be allowed to change gis at the referees direction without penalty.

Entry Fees: No entry fee. Donations welcome!

Referee and Table Staff Training: Thanks to those of you that come out and volunteer your time to run Arizona Judo tournaments! These events focus on training new referees and table help, so come on out and volunteer!

Eligibility: Proof of current insurance membership in USJA, USJF or USA Judo is required. Foreign players must provide current insurance membership in their country's recognized national Judo organization. There is no Arizona residency requirement. All competitors must be 14 years old or younger on the date of the event.

Divisions: All divisions are determined at the time of weigh-ins and are subject to modification based on entries. Each skill, gender and age category will be separated into weight divisions, generally: light, middle and heavy. All decisions by the tournament director are final. Junior Novice is defined as a player who holds a rank of yellow belt or below or pending tournament director's discretion.
