Contest Rules: Modified IJF rules: Arm locks permitted in Senior B (Sr-B) and Masters Divisions! No arm locks permitted in any junior division, no choking for competitors under 13 years of age. Match Length: 3 Minutes: All Junior and Masters Division, 5 Minutes: All Senior Divisions, Juniors 10 years of age and under can play in coed divisions.

Player called first is White (must wear White Gi), Player called second is Blue (must wear blue gi or white gi with blue belt). If the first contestant arrives to the mat wearing a blue gi, they will be disqualified! TWO BLUE GI CANNOT PLAY!

Eligibility: Open to current members of the USJI, USJF, & USJA; Jr. Div. 16 yr. & under; Sr. Div. 17 yr. & over. Jr. may play in Sr. Div.; anyone may play in a heavier Div. for an additional fee. All competitors must present a valid card from the USJA, USJF, or USJI in order to compete. Membership forms for the USJA/JF/JI will be available at registration.

Prizes: Awards for 1st, 2nd, & two 3rd Places.

Perpetual Team Trophy awarded to the Club scoring the most points

1st Place-5pts, 2nd Place-3pts, 3rd Place-1pt.
